What is EU Aid Volunteers?

EU Aid Volunteers connects volunteers and organisations from different countries in joint projects as a practical expression of solidarity with communities vulnerable to humanitarian crises.

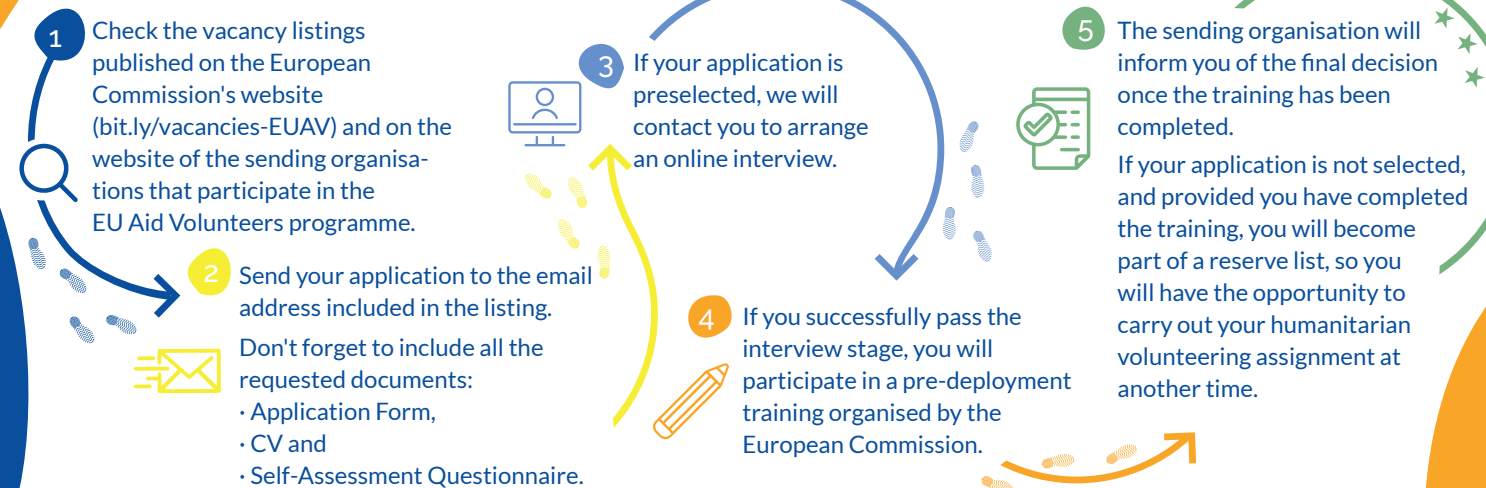
EU Aid Volunteers is a European Union initiative that provides humanitarian volunteering opportunities, both in the field and online, to EU citizens and long-term residents in EU member countries with different professional backgrounds. It also provides technical support and resources to organisations for their strengthening and resilience in humanitarian aid contexts.

You can participate...

If you are over 18 years of age, have European Union citizenship or a long-term residence permit in an EU Member State and are willing to travel and live in another country, you are eligible to carry out an on-site volunteering assignment of between two and eighteen months.

* If you are unable to travel, you can also volunteer online, whatever your nationality.

What steps do I need to take in order to become an EU Aid Volunteer?



This experience includes...

- Pre-deployment training in the sending organisation in the EU and an induction upon arrival in the field.
- Mentoring and support throughout the humanitarian volunteering assignment.
- Integration into a professional team with extensive experience in the management of humanitarian and volunteering projects.
- Active participation in the day-to-day life of your host organisation, being part of the team and the projects in the field.
- Training in health and safety protocols, before and during your volunteering assignment.
- Accommodation, travel, visa, vaccination, and health insurance expenses covered by your sending organisation.
- Monthly allowance to help cover your daily expenses.
- Relocation allowance upon your return to the European Union.

In addition, you will be part of a *European corp of solidarity*, thus contributing to improving situations of global inequality and injustice.
