

## II EDITION PHOTO CONTEST “TRANSFORMING SOCIAL REALITIES”

Movement for Peace -MPDL- launches the II Edition of the Photo Contest "Transforming social realities" at international level. This edition is presented in the midst of a global health and social emergency. We are facing exceptional situations that restrict our freedom of movement as a consequence of the State of Alarm and the established quarantine in many countries. At the same time, expressions of solidarity and mutual care, as well as collective attitudes of social support are showing up all over the world.

In this Edition, the Photo Contest *Transforming social realities* aims to become a collective memory “in images” of these expressions of solidarity, mutual support and individual and community care that go beyond borders. In short, it seeks the reflection of the daily support and collaborative actions, showing the necessary hope and human strength to overcome this or any other global crisis.

In **2020**, the Photo Contest *Transforming social realities* puts the spotlight on:

- **Care.** Individual, collective and community initiatives that emerge and transform this context of crisis into acts and evidences of support, struggle, solidarity and hope.
- **Responsibility.** Reflections on our social model: rediscovering essential needs and priorities; our neighborhood relationships and the responsibilities as individuals for the common good.

### PARTICIPANTS

Any person from anywhere, without age limit can take part. Children and young people under the age of 18 should also provide the consent of parents or legal guardians (see section 2.4).

### THEME

The II Edition of Photo Contest "*Transforming social realities*" aims to showcase photographs of care and solidarity expressions putting a human face to this health and social emergency. Supporting and collaborative actions, as well as individual and collective experiences that contribute to overcoming this global crisis.

Photographs may also show any expression, action, feeling or concern about this theme. Here you have some ideas that may help you to focus on your pictures:

- What expressions of support and relief, individual or collective, are being more exciting for you?
- What type of images are showing hope and strength in this global crisis?
- What samples of care are you doing with yourself and your home environment?
- Who would you like to thank for their support, effort and work they are doing?
- What would you like to show as an act of love and solidarity in this social and health crisis?

(In addition, you must describe in detail your photographs in the Participation Form)

## CONTEST RULES

### SECTION 1: PHOTOGRAPHS

1.1 FORMAT OF PHOTOGRAPHS: Photos may be taken with any type of camera device (analogical or digital camera, mobile phone...etc.) according to the following characteristics:

- Photographs must be in color or black and white. Digital format JPG or PNG with a minimum resolution of 2160 x 1836 pixels. As first option, they will be sent via email. If photographs are in very high-resolution version and cannot be attached, you can send them via Wetransfer (<https://wetransfer.com/>)

### SECTION 2: HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR PICTURE?

2.1 DEADLINE: **extended until June 5<sup>th</sup> 2020 including**

2.2 NUMBER OF PHOTOGRAPHS: 2 photos maximum per participant.

2.4 DOCUMENTS TO BE SENT: together with photographs, the following documents are also required. These documents are available to be downloaded from Movement for Peace-MPDL website [www.mpdl.org](http://www.mpdl.org):

- **Participation Form (PF)**: Each photograph must be submitted together with the Participant Form (PF). In the case of sending two photographs, participants should submit one PF per each photo. All information provided by participants on the PF must be accurate and complete:

- a) Work title
- b) Brief description (500 caracteres maximum)
- c) Country – Region- Place (where the photograph was taken)
- d) Authorship: first/last name, place of residence, phone number and email.
- e) ID scanned document (passport, residence document or any other identification document)

▪ **Transfer of rights:**

- a) Transfer of rights by the participant or legal representative allowing the use of personal data and the photographs received in the framework of the II Edition of Photo Contest "Transforming social realities". This transfer of rights means that Movement for Peace-MPDL will have the right to edit and exhibit the photographs received, without any limit of time, format or media, with full credit of the photographer, in any case.

- b) Transfer of rights by individuals who appear in the photographs. It can be done in two ways:

1) *Consent form signed by individuals who appear in the photographs* allowing the transfer of their images and the right to be reproduced, edited and exhibited by MOVIMIENTO POR LA PAZ -MPDL-, without any limit of time, format or media.

2) *Responsible Statement signed by the photograph's author* certifying to have the consent of individuals who appear in the photograph for using their images. In this case, the author will be responsible for any legal incident on the use of these images in the frame of II Edition of Photo Contest "Transforming social realities", exempting Movement for Peace-MPDL from any responsibility.

**Children and young people under the age of 18 may appear in the photographs from the back or from a perspective that prevents their recognition. They can only be recognized if parents or legal guardians express their consent in the Participation form (PF).**

Participants under the age of 18 or individuals under guardianship, should indicate their age or condition on the PF. In this case, both parties must sign the Participant form (section F), in order to grant the same compliance of rights described in point 2.4 of this document.

To be under the supervision of parents or legal guardian throughout the participation process, for those who are under the age of 18 or individuals under guardianship will be an indispensable requirement.

- **Responsible statement of the original and unpublished nature of the photographs.** Photographs whose intellectual property rights do not belong fully and without exception to the person participating in the contest will not be accepted.

- **Acceptance of Privacy policy on personal data, signed by the participant:**

"MOVEMENT FOR PEACE, DISARMAMENT AND FREEDOM" (MPDL), informs you that your personal data will be processed for your participation in the II Photography Competition "Realities in Transformation", including its public dissemination by the entity in the exhibition to be held on the occasion of the awards ceremony, as well as any format and space they consider appropriate for the promotion and visibility of examples of mutual support, solidarity and human rights anywhere in the world. The data will be transferred to third parties with your consent and to the necessary extent to suppliers or by legal obligation. You have the right to withdraw your consent, access, rectify and delete the data, as well as other rights, as explained in the additional information. ## SECTION 3: SELECTION OF WORKS AND JURY

### 3.1 SELECTION OF WORKS

First, there will be carried out an evaluation according to the criteria and rules of the Contest by the Social Mobilization and Communication Department.

Subsequently, 12 finalists and 1 winning photograph will be selected by the jury. The jury will be composed of staff from Movement for Peace-MPDL, representatives of collaborating organizations and companies, and professionals with extensive experience in the field of photography.

In addition, public in general may also vote 1 photograph in the category of "winning photograph by popular vote" through our website [www.mpd.org](http://www.mpd.org).

**Decision** will be announced as follows:

- first half of July 2020, the 12 finalists of the Contest will be announced, in accordance with the jury's decision.
- second half of September 2020, the 2 winning photographic works of the Contest (by the jury and popular votes) will be announced. Participants whose works result selected as finalists and/or winners will be notified by email or phone call, as well as through our institutional channels.

The selected photographs will be used for exhibitions, events or any other visibility spaces that Movement for Peace-MPDL will consider for the promotion of the Solidarity and the Human Rights in accordance with the social causes that our NGO defends.

#### **SECTION 4: PRIZES**

Two prizes will be awarded for the II Edition of the Photo Contest "*Transforming social realities*"

1. Winner by choice of the jury will receive 1 gift card to be exchanged for Fair Trade and/or solidarity economy products value at 300 euros.
2. Winner by popular vote will receive 1 gift card to be exchanged for Fair Trade and/or solidarity economy products worth 300 euros.

Likewise, the 12 finalist photographs will become part of the exhibition of the contest and their authors will receive an individual certificate as finalists of the II Edition of the Photo Contest "*Transforming social realities*".

**The awards ceremony will take place on October 9, 2020 in Madrid**, where a photographic exhibition will be organized with the finalist and winning works. In addition, we will have the opportunity for sharing ideas, views and good practices with a relevant person from the photography field.
